Job description/duties:

Data collectors receive a zone in their city with locations where we need data collected. Data is uploaded at each location using the collector's mobile phone. Job qualifications:

- A recent and capable smartphone model with a data plan.
- Strong familiarity with smartphones and apps, especially navigation apps. Must know how to turn on GPS ("location services" on iPhones).
- You can easily find your location on the map. You can point out the block and side of street that you are on, even when the GPS is not working.
- The ability to move efficiently through your city. A Bicycle/Scooter/Skateboard is helpful.
- Attention to detail and sharp observation. The ability to execute technical testing and data collection methodologies accurately and precisely.
- Accountability and reliability. We can depend on you to deliver the data on time.
- Available and committed to work 8-24 hours per week for at least one (1) month.
